

## Acts 1

The ascension of Jesus, Great Commission, election of Matthias as apostle.

## Acts 2

Pentacost, Peter's sermon, 3000 saved/baptized, all things in common

## Acts 3

Peter and temple healing and sermon.

## Acts 4

Apostles are arrested after temple sermon, 5000 men saved, detained until the next day, interrogated and released. Christians had all things in common.

## Acts 5

Annanias and Sapphira. Church grows, ppl are being healed. Apostles jailed by religious leaders. Angel breaks them out. Confronted the next day the high priest. They were let go after being beaten.

## Acts 6

Disciples chosen to help minister to weak and old, apostles focus on the word and prayer.

Religious leaders debate with Stephen, set up false witnesses against him.

Stephen's sermon and death

## Acts 8

Philip preaches in Samaria, Peter confronts Simon the sorcerer. Philip runs to the Ethiopian eunuch's caravan and preaches Jesus, eunuch is baptized

## Acts 9

Saul is converted. And is guided by disciples to Jerusalem after he preaches Christ in Damascus.

Peter heals Aeneas and revives Dorcas.

## Acts 10

The Lord arranges for Gentiles to hear and be saved also, just like the Jews. God is no respecter of peoples. Cornelius and his men are converted, speak tongues, and are baptized.

## Acts 11

Peter rehearses the matter of Cornelius before the church elders in Jerusalem, the Jews begin to preach to Gentiles and many are saved. They send Barnabas to Antioch who meets Paul in Tarsus and brings him back to Antioch. Finally a prophet tells the people of a drought that will affect Judah, so Antioch decides to send relief to them.

## Acts 12

Peter escapes from prison, Herod gets eaten by worms, Barnabas and Paul return with John Mark.

## Acts 13

Antioch Church sends Paul and Barnabas. Paul confronts Elymas the sorcerer and blinds him. The deputy gets saved. Paul preaches in Pisidia in the synagogue. Jews reject the word. Gentiles are saved, Jews are jealous and cause persecution for Paul and Barnabas, they are expelled from the city.

## Acts 14

Paul and Barnabas preach in Iconium and heal a cripple. People try to worship them as gods. Paul forbids them and the Jews that came from other cities stone Paul and leave him outside the city supposing he was dead.

## Acts 15

There rose up a dispute in Antioch that Gentile Christians should be circumcised and follow the law of Moses or they could not be saved. Paul and Barnabas dispute for sometime the men decide it's good to send a group to Jerusalem to ask the Apostles and the church elders. When they do, Peter rehearses the matter of Cornelius and eventually the men decide that Gentile Christians do not have to be circumcised or follow the law, but they did "burden" them to not eat meat offered to idols, things that were strangled to death, blood, and abstain from fornication.

## Acts 16

Timothy meets Paul and joins him, Paul casts the devil out of the slave diviner girl, Paul receives the Macedonian call, Philippian jailer is saved and his family.

Paul ministers in Corinth 1.5 years

Acts 19

Paul ministers 2 years in Ephesus. Uproar at Ephesus

Acts 20

Paul leaves Ephesus, boy falls three stories and lives.

Acts 21

Paul sails to Jerusalem, gets arrested at the temple and prepares to address the crowd.

Acts 22

Paul's gives his testimony before the angry mob, they reject him. The captain holds to him to know why they accused him.

Acts 23

Paul before the council. Vow against Paul's life. Centurion takes Paul to Felix

Acts 24

Orator accuses Paul before Felix, Paul makes his defense and stay in Jerusalem two years, Felix hoping to get some money from him.

Acts 25

Felix desire to have him stand trial before the Jews. Paul appeals to ceasar. King Agrippa comes to see Felix and hears about Paul.

Acts 26

Paul gives his testimony before king Agrippa

Acts 27

Paul sets sail for Rome, shipwrecked.  
Acts 28

Paul and company is shipwrecked, arrive later in Rome, lives there two years in his own house preaching the gospel in Rome.
